The MF Health Centre conducted follow-ups on the confirmed cases and a majority of them have or are recovering from the flu illness.

### Severity Level for the Community: 'Moderate to Severe'

**Local Schools:** Due to the high number (60-70%) of students absent with Influenza-Like Illnesses, all local schools remain closed today. The school authorities are monitoring the community flu situation and will issue public posting concerning school operations.

**H1N1 Flu Immunization Clinic:** Approximately 1,010 community members have now been immunized. The Public Health Centre will operate the H1N1 Immunization Clinics again on the following dates at the EPR Pandemic Control Centre:

- Thursday November 5/09: 1:00 p.m. - 4:00 p.m.
- Friday November 6/09: 1:00 p.m. - 4:00 p.m.

Again, we strongly encourage everyone that can get the H1N1 vaccine to get their needle as soon as possible. **The Vaccine along with health prevention practices is our best protection to control and contain the H1N1 Virus.**
