Matrimonial Real Property Steering Committee

The role of the Matrimonial Real Property Steering Committee is to assist the Moose Cree First Nation initiative to develop its own Matrimonial Real Property Law.

This law applies to married couples and common-law partners living on reserve. It is to provide basic protections and rights to individuals living on reserves regarding the family home and other matrimonial interests and rights during a conjugal relationship in the event of a breakdown of that relationship, and on the death of their spouse or common-law partner.

Under our Capacity Development agreement with the First Nations Market Housing Fund, the Housing Department will be heading this initiative.

Until a First Nation develops and approves its own Matrimonial Real Property Law they will fall under the law coming into effect on December 16, 2014.
