BOIL WATER ADVISORY ISSUED

Sunday, February, 14, 2016

Affected Community: Moose Factory, On.

In the interest of protecting public health, a **BOIL WATER ADVISORY** is being issued, effective immediately. The Boil Water Advisory is being issued due to a **WATER MAIN BREAK**.

A Boil Water Advisory means that people who take their water from the communal supply system should follow the advice in the accompanying fact sheet from Porcupine Health Unit, called ‘How to use water safely during a “boil water advisory”’.

The Break has been located, we will continue to monitor the situation and will notify the residents when the boil water advisory has been lifted. *Please note, water line repairs may cause reduced water pressure or temporary loss of water, and it may also cause discolored water. Once service is restored, run your cold water until it is clear.*

If you prefer not to boil your water, an alternate source of drinking water is made available to you at the Water Plant. Hours of operation are from 7:30 AM to 16:00 PM. Please, bring your own clean container.
