MCFN is seeking applicants for the Veterans' Land Issue Committee

This Committee is tasked with identifying a course of action that will allow Chief and Council to resolve the veterans' land issue.

The committee shall be comprised of
a Chairperson, and 6 members.

- The Chairperson shall be an independent individual with experience in governance and/or senior management. The Chairperson should be a non-band member who holds the trust and confidence of the First Nation as a whole. The Chairperson will not hold voting power, even in a stalemate, as the role is to guide the parties to a consensus-based solution.
- Three (3) members shall represent veterans and their families.
- Three (3) members shall represent membership as a whole and shall have not be in any conflict of interest with the families of the veterans.
