What is the Treaty Land Entitlement (TLE) Claim?

Moose Cree First Nation has demonstrated that the First Nation was shortchanged 12.65 square miles of land when Treaty No. 9 was signed in 1905. This work came to form a specific claim, which was accepted for negotiation by the Federal Government and the Provincial Government. We must now identify land options that we are interested in securing, and identify the advantages and disadvantages of each option. You will help us decide which options best suit our needs both now and in the future.
