SEASON CLOSURE EXTENSION



Effective Monday, March 31, 2014 at 12:00 noon, the Wetum Road will officially close for the season.

Extension Notice

In collaboration with leadership and the Wetum Road Contractors and in consideration of membership's requests, the deadline for closure of the Wetum Road has been extended to Monday, March 31, 2014 at 12 noon. Please practice safe driving, watch your speed and slow down at the crossings. As well, please consider the environment and do not litter on the Wetum Road. Meegwetch.

Part of closure of Wetum Road is the decommissioning of the river crossings. In order to do this, the road has to be in favourable condition to allow for the heavy equipment/machinery to access the road. Otherwise, the impending warm weather can adversely affect/prevent the movement of the required heavy equipment into the area of the decommissioning of creeks and crossings. **Decommissioning is a requirement under the work permit.**

Work Permit MO-13-005 - Construction of Weetum Winter Road - Requirement 25;

All water crossings are to be decommissioned upon closure of the road per condition 45 of this schedule. When the crossing season is over and where it is safe to do so, create a V-notch in the centre of the icebridge to allow it to melt from the centre and also to prevent blocking fish passage, channel erosion and flooding. Compacted snow shall be removed from snow fills prior to the spring freshet.
