# BITE

An untied dog is a potential hazard. Any dog can become aggressive, putting the safety of community members at risk, especially children and elders. Dog attacks are preventable, and keeping your dog inside or tied can prevent someone from being severely injured or even killed. Know the risk, and do your part as a responsible pet owner to prevent a tragedy before it happens.

In an attempt to address the dog control issue and to ensure the health and safety of the community, an interim dog control program will be in effect beginning May 2018. Dogs roaming freely will be caught and stored in a temporary holding facility, where owners will have a chance to claim their pet before they are sent out of the community or destroyed.
