Treaty Land Entitlement Claim **INFORMATION SESSION**

When Treaty 9 was signed in 1905, MCFN received less land than it should have, a total of 12.65 square miles. MCFN is now negotiating the Treaty Land Entitlement (TLE) claim with Ontario and Canada.

The governments of Ontario and Canada have accepted this claim and MCFN is now at the stage of looking at land selection options within the Treaty 9 area that will become additional MCFN reserve territory. MCFN is also negotiating for financial compensation for “Loss of Use” of this land.
