



MOOSE FACTORY ISLAND FIRE & RESCUE

RIVER SURVEILLANCE REPORT #1

DATE: April 21, 2015 **TIME:** 11:00 a.m.

A river surveillance flight was taken this morning and the following was noticed at the locations listed below:

South Bluff Creek – Still intact with water rising

Bushy Island South End – Still intact with water rising along shore

French River – Still intact with open areas and water rising

Kwatabohegan River – Still intact with water rising

Abitibi River – Still intact with water rising

Cheepash River – Still intact with water rising

Moose River (main river) – Still intact with a small break up 38 miles from Moose Factory, Still Intact from Moose River Bridge to Missinaibe

Missinaibe – Broken up to mouth, ice pack is 2-3 miles long with open water above that

The flow rates and water levels that are monitored at Moose River are rising and that is expected this time of year. All other rivers/creeks remain normal for this time of year.

Another Flight will take place to monitor the water levels and progress of break-up
