Information and updates for the 2014 - 2015 season



UPDATE #1: Posted December 31, 2014

CURRENT ESTIMATED OPENING DATE: **SATURDAY, JANUARY 10, 2014**

North End:

40 km

The Wetum Road is currently under construction for its third season. Moose Cree First Nation asks that all vehicles remain off the road during this phase.

Latest Update:

The north side of the Wetum Road is drivable up to 40km. The crew working on the north side crossed the North French River with snowcats on December 30th.

South End:

35 km

The south side is drivable for 35km. Snowcats crossed Big Cedar Creek on December 29th and the crew expects to reach the halfway mark by December 31st. If weather remains cold, it is possible to see some traffic by January 10th.

General information:

The Wetum Road connects Moose Factory to the Ontario highway system. The Wetum Road ends at Otter Rapids. From there, you can connect to highway 634, which leads to Smooth Rock Falls.

The Wetum Road has a total length of 170 kilometres, plus an additional 130 kilometres from Otter Rapids to Smooth Rock Falls. Plan to spend approximately five (5) hours driving the entire 300km trip.

Moose Cree First Nation is pleased to provide you with this additional travel option. There is no toll to use the road. Check points are in place for statistic gathering purposes only. Please drive carefully and be aware of road crews operating on the road.
