

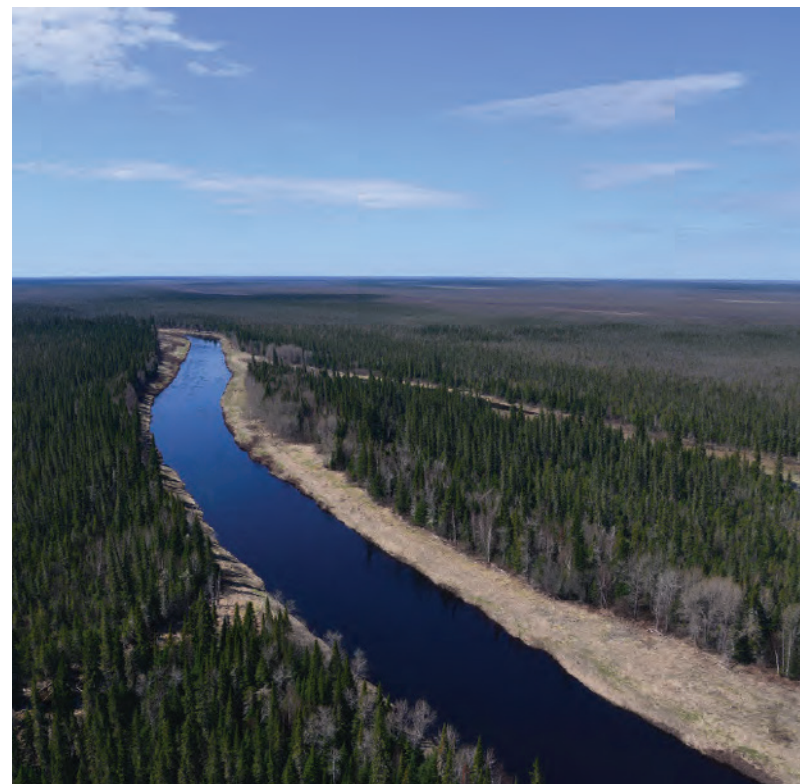


Treaty Land Entitlement Claim UPDATE SESSIONS

These sessions will provide MCFN members with an update on the TLE Claim negotiations with the provincial and federal governments.

What is the MCFN Treaty Land Entitlement Negotiation Claim about?

Moose Cree First Nation has demonstrated that the First Nation was shortchanged 12.65 square miles of reserve land when Treaty No. 9 was signed in 1905. Both Canada and Ontario have acknowledged this mistake and now we must identify land options that we are interested in making reserve land. At these sessions, we will identify the advantages and disadvantages of each option. We are seeking input from the Moose Cree Membership in order to decide upon which options suit our needs both now and in the future.
