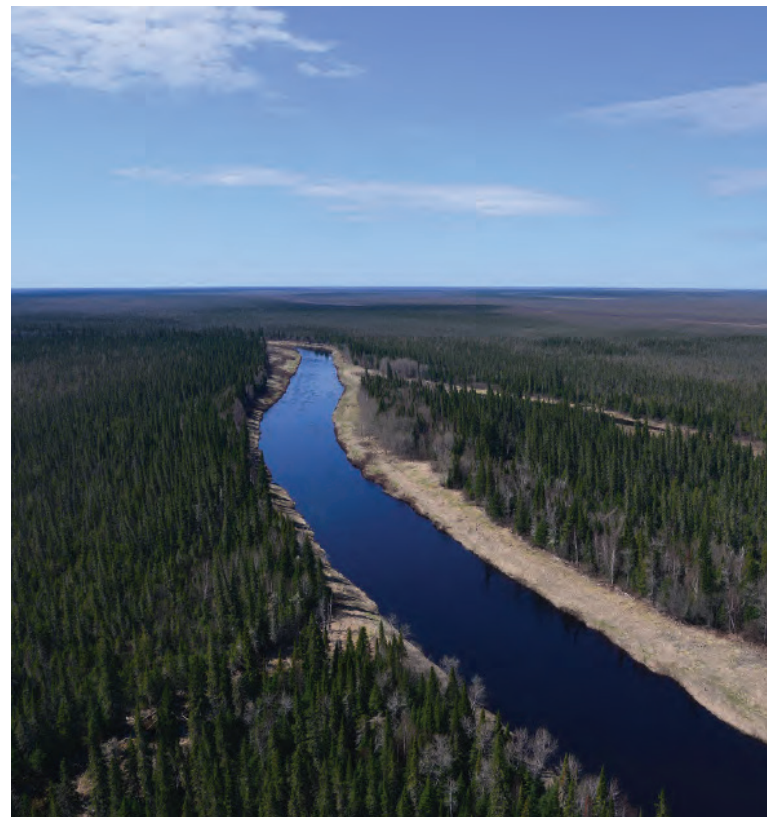




Treaty Land Entitlement Claim UPDATE SESSIONS

What is the MCFN Treaty Land Entitlement Negotiation Claim about?

Moose Cree First Nation has demonstrated that the First Nation was shortchanged 12.65 square miles of reserve land when Treaty No. 9 was signed in 1905. Both Canada and Ontario have acknowledged this mistake and have agreed to negotiate a Treaty Land Entitlement Agreement with MCFN. These information sessions will update the members on the progress that has been made and follow up on the information that was presented last year. We will present the sites that have been identified and discuss each of them. We are seeking input from the Moose Cree Membership before finalizing the list of potential land sites to be added to the MCFN reserve. The TLE negotiations will have a long term benefit to MCFN and we urge members to participate.
