



Water Conservation Notice Update

Thursday, November 16, 2017

Area Affected: **Moose Factory, ON.**

Unfortunately, Public Works water personnel have not yet located all the leak(s) in the distribution system. With that, the water plant cannot make enough water to compensate for the amount of water that is being lost through the leak(s).

In order to maintain adequate water levels in the reservoir to try to provide enough water for daily activities and fire emergencies, the pressure will once again be reduced this evening beginning at **6:00 PM and full pressure will be restored on Friday, November 17, 2017, 2015 at 6:00 AM.** This will have to continue daily until there are sufficient levels in our reservoirs.
